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DATA REVIEW

- Strong Growth in Literacy and Mathematics on SBAC (Level 5 for most)
- Strong Growth in Literacy and Mathematics on iReady (over a year of growth in literacy and >8 months in mathematics)
- Attendance rate continues to improve
- Female CTE enrollment increased last year and decreased again this year.
- Parents reporting that they find the school to be trustworthy has doubled since the 2023 Cognia survey
- No statistical difference between students of color and white students in literacy or mathematics.
- No statistical difference between students of color and white students in mathematics growth, but there is a statistical difference in literacy growth (both exceed projected growth of .5 year)
- Students report a need for mental health support and bullying prevention
- General strong support for current IG initiatives

Outcome Early Literacy

Strategy Early Lit 1 Provide high dosage tutoring for students who need Tier 2 Instruction

Strategy Early Lit 2 Provide professional development, specifically in the area of helping students produce quality narrative, expository, and persuasive text

Outcome A Students will have access to performing arts opportunities
