 - State assessments TCAP, Gateway Assessments, and End of Course Assessments—Yearly

 - Make appointments before and after school
 - Email
 - Use student planners to communicate
5. Provide parents opportunities to volunteer and participate in their child's class and to observe classroom activities
 - Chaperoning field trips
 - Assist teachers with specific curriculum activities as needed
 - Complete projects at home
 - Participate in various school functions, such as, student performance nights
