What is A.L.L.?

“Academic Learning Lab” is a new innovative program that is encompassed by HOPE Academy. The program is for scholars on Independent Study and for scholars that are intrinsically motivated to participate in experiences that will propel academic excellence.

Who is Eligible?

- **Students who have been placed by the Williamsburg County School Disciplinary Committee**
- **Parent choice for a smaller setting**
- **Students with chronic absenteeism and who are truant**
- **Students with repeated (documented) disciplinary infractions**
- **Students that have committed Level 3 Infractions**
- **Students identified as having specific handicapping conditions, if the IEP committee determines placement is necessary**
- **Students returning from a residential or long-term program**

Purpose

To work with scholars' in meeting their education SC High School credit requirements. Collaborate with other teachers, instructors, and staff members to create an optimal learning and care environment. Provide helpful feedback to parents and guardians on a regular or as needed basis.

A.L.L. is a hybrid learning platform and it targets grades 8th -12th. The program will decrease drop-out rates and increase credit recovery.
