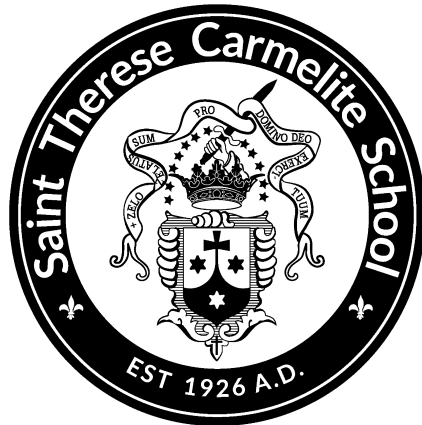

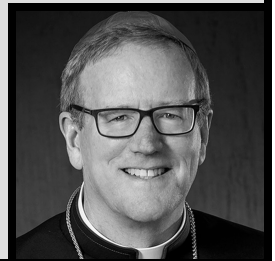


Discover the figures who shaped the Church and changed the world!

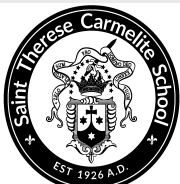
