2022-2023 Advanced Degree Supplements

Advance Degree	Pay
Master's	\$3,650
Specialist's	\$6,650
Doctorate	\$9,500
Master Craftsman **	\$3,650

Employees will be paid for the highest degree supplement earned in addition to the base pay for their Bachelor's degree. In order to receive credit for advanced degrees, (Master's, Specialist and Doctorate) employees must provide an official transcript of record showing that award of earned degree to the Personnel Office. Per the Student Success Act (SB 736) effective July 1, 2011, teachers hired by Taylor County Schools on or after July 1, 2011, must possess an advanced degree in their area of certification to be eligible to receive credit.

** Employees hired after July 1, 2020 shall receive \$3,650 as a Master Craftsman supplement provided they have 15 years or more of verified experience in a vocational field. Any employee who receives an advanced degree supplement shall not be eligible for the Master Craftsman supplement.
