- Good attendance

- Overall good standing with their school
- Academy application completed
- Transcript Review
- Recommendation letter from administrator (School/District)
- Recommendation form from teachers (3)
- Essay explaining why you would be an excellent candidate for one of our academies
- Complete Troy University admission process
