Students who qualify for this program attend classes face-to-face at Troy University where they integrate into traditional classes with traditional, full-time college students. The goal for this program is to allow students not already participating in Dual Enrollment Associate Degree Programs the opportunity to take dual enrollment English and History classes.

The Global Studies Academy provides these students with a head start toward their continuing, post-secondary education.

According to a study conducted by the American Institutes for Research (2013), students who earn 15 or more dual enrollment hours are 1) more likely to graduate high school, 2) more likely to enroll in continuing post-secondary education, and 3) more likely to earn a degree.


