DRESS CODE:

DO NOT submit a photo that has any of the following:

- Attire, which is not neat, clean, and non-disruptive.
- Visible tattoos.
- No other people or pets in the picture.
- Weapons of any kind.
- Anything that promotes, advertises, implies, or suggests the use of drugs, alcohol, or tobacco.
- Obscenity, lewdness, or lack of respect.
- Anything that is inflammatory to any race, religion, or heritage.
- Anything that identifies, promotes, or relates to gangs or gang affiliation.

PHOTO SPECIFICATIONS

Seniors may choose their own photographer. However, please choose a **reputable photographer** so you get a quality photo. Failure to submit photos with proper specifications can result in a photo that does not print well in the yearbook.

- Photo size 2x3 portrait view. NOT 3x2 landscape view.
- Photo dpi 300
- **Submit JPEG files only**. The yearbook staff will not re-size or re-format photos submitted in other formats.
- Submit the original photo. DO NOT send screenshots, drop box links, or your online photo gallery.
- Submit photos by using the link that will be sent after school starts.
- Students who do not submit a senior portrait will have their school senior ID photo listed in the yearbook in the senior section.
- If you do not want to submit a portrait AND your ID photo included, please contact Mrs. Debernardi in room 505.
