What's Happening:

Happy November! We are continually learning new things every day. We are busy working on numbers and learning about our Superkid, Golly and will be introduced to Alf next week.

We have been working on writing and recognizing all the upper and lower case letters of the alphabet and numbers 0-20. We will keep working on writing letters and numbers every day.

We will start to identify onset (beginning sound) and rime (ending sound) of a word and identify where individual words begin and end, as they are separated by spaces. In the coming weeks we will start working on addition equations to 5.

ABC Letter Sounds & Names:

Keep practicing saying their letter names and sounds at home nightly.

Heart Words:

Go through these cards multiple times a week.

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Academic Standards

Math:

1. Count to 100 by 1's, 2's, 5's, and 10's.
2. Can count forward beyond 20.
3. Can count backwards from 20 consecutively.
4. Can write & identify numbers 0-20 and match number to the correct amount of objects.
5. Students can add numbers to 5.
6. Students can compare three shapes and describe their similarities and differences using attributes and vocabulary.

Reading:

1. Know letter names & sounds.
2. Fluently read all Quarter 1 sight words.
3. Students can identify the onset and rime of a word.
4. Students will identify where words begin and end, as they are separated by spaces.

Writing:

1. Students can create a piece of functional writing.
2. Write all letters of the alphabet.
3. Students can sort and create a rule for objects they are giving, and verbally explain their rule.

Science:

1. Dealing with Weather

*Weather conditions, weather patterns, weather hazards, and energy from the sun.

Social Studies:

1. I can recognize that my classmates have different traditions that may be alike in some ways and different in others.
2. I can explain and explore American holidays.
3. Identify personal traits, such as courage, honesty, and responsibility.
