The Spanish Honor Society of Fuqua School Sociedad Honoraria Hispánica del Colegio Fuqua (SHH)

<u>Goals</u>

- to recognize those students who, on the basis of academic grades and performance, merit special note for past and current accomplishment in Spanish;
- to encourage those students to further their abilities within the discipline of Spanish; and
- to encourage members to use their talents to serve others.

Eligibility Requirements

- 1. Completed, is currently enrolled, or will be enrolled in the spring in Spanish III;
- Achieved a minimum GPA of 3.3 in Spanish (based on final end-of-course grades). Students whose GPA for Spanish I and II falls short but whose GPA for Spanish III and IV is a 4.0 also qualify;
- 3. Meets Fuqua School's minimum standard for overall GPA (not on academic probation);
- 4. Committed no serious behavior violation (level III or higher) throughout the previous academic year nor behaved in a manner that resulted in behavior probation.

Application Process

- 1. Complete and submit The Spanish Honor Society of Fuqua School application to the sponsor of the society.
- 2. Submit a statement of academic eligibility, noting the Spanish GPA.
- 3. Write a paragraph in Español saying why you would like to be in the Society and plan to meet once a quarter to have lunch in Español together.

Election

Students who meet all eligibility requirements and successfully complete all application requirements as determined by the SHH Advisory Committee shall be elected into membership.

Membership Retention

Students who fall below the standards that formed the basis for their selection as members shall be warned in writing by the society's Advisory Committee Chair and given a reasonable amount of time to correct the deficiency, except in the case of the flagrant violation of school rules or the law, in which case a warning will be waved. If the deficiency is not corrected, membership will be terminated.
