Most St. Anne families turned in their bus forms for next year. They were due in May & June. If you still have not turned them in, please submit one to the Main Office Atten: Mrs. Reichard or email a slip over to:

The longer you wait, the districts cannot guarantee you will have busing for the start of the school year.

### St. Anne School PSA, Parents and Volunteers:

Thank you to the <u>many</u> new parent volunteers who obtained their required Child Protection Clearances this past school year!!!

#### NEW Per the Diocese of Allentown Safe Environment Directive - Effective July 25, 2025:

**St. Anne School and Parish Volunteers:** ANYONE who wishes to volunteer IN ANY CAPACITY---regardless if you will or will not have contact with children, is now required to obtain all Child Protection Clearances. *For Example:* 

\*If you volunteer to cook at an event, decorate, or take tickets and will not directly supervise children, you are now required to obtain your clearances.

\*If you volunteer with a parish organization or are a reader at Mass, Eucharistic Minister, you are now required to obtain your clearances.

\*If you participate as a CYO coach, snack bar volunteer, line judge, scorekeeper, scout leader, etc. you are now required to obtain your clearances.

\*\*\*\*\*IF YOU HAVE NOT YET COMPLETED YOUR NATIONAL SEX OFFENDER REGISTRY (NSOR) CLEARANCE ---PLEASE fill out the attached application & email it to the address listed on the form ASAP. When you receive this clearance in the mail, forward it to Eileen Brida(see below) or drop it at the school office. YOU WILL NOT be permitted to volunteer in the future without this clearance!

\*Assistance/Information for obtaining clearances is always available.

\*Group presentations, mobile Finger Printing and in-person Mandated Reporter training sessions are being scheduled. Dates/Information will be emailed and posted. \*If you believe you may wish to volunteer, or may wish to schedule an information session for your school/parish volunteer organization, wish to obtain your clearances or, if you have any questions about your clearances, please contact:

### APPLICATION: National Sex Offender Registry Verification

The following individuals must complete the National Sex Offender Registry verification application:

- Any individual 18 years or older residing in the child care setting where child care is occurring.
- Any individual working for a Regulated Child Care Provider.
- Any individual with an ownership interest (corporate or non-corporate) in a Regulated Child Care Provider and who participates in the organization and management of the operation.
- Any volunteer of a child care provider, group day-care home or family child care home.

Type or print clearly in ink. Fill in all necessary fields on the application. Once completed, use one of the following three options to submit the application for processing:

- Mail to the Clearance Verification Unit, ChildLine at the following address: Department of Human Services PO Box 8170 Harrisburg, PA 17105-8170; OR
- 2. Scan the completed application and email to: <a href="mailto:RA-PWNSOR@pa.gov">RA-PWNSOR@pa.gov</a> In the subject line list 'NSOR Verification Applicant Last Name (i.e., Smith); OR
- 3. Hand deliver to the Clearance Verification Unit drop off box located at: 2525 North 7<sup>th</sup> Street, Harrisburg, PA 17110. Free parking is available in the visitor's lot at front of the building.
  - Processing time is fourteen days from the date the application is received.
  - Retain a copy of the completed application for your record. You may need a copy as proof of your submission for your employer.
  - There is no fee for the National Sex Offender Registry verification letter.
  - Refer all questions to the Clearance Verification Unit at 877-371-5422.

## St. Anne Parish/ School "CYO" Safe Environment Requirements

In addition to ALL the Parish/School Volunteer Safe Environment Requirements, ALL COACHES, per the Diocese CYO, are required to complete these <u>Annual CYO COACHES</u> Clearances:

Annual Sudden Cardiac Arrest Training: valid year 7/1 through 6/30. Each coach must take this training once every new school year.

Annual Heads-Up Concussion Certification: valid 7/1 through 6/30 of each school year. Each coach must take this training once every new school year.

Coaches Code of Conduct: valid for one year, updated annually.

(note): If you complete your certifications for spring sports for example in March, and wish to coach in the fall – the Cardiac and Concussion trainings must be completed again for the new school year.






