## **Baseball**

The Varsity Baseball team had quite a memorable and historic 2024 season! The teams advanced all the way to the New York State Semi Finals in Binghamton. After finishing the regular season with a record of 9-8 and finishing 4th in the Adirondack League playoffs, the team got Sectionals started with a victory over *Argyle 8-0*. Next, they dispatched *Hartford/Fort Edward by a score of 10-9* in the semifinals to advance to the Section 2 Championship game vs *Mekeel Christian* @ Joe Bruno Stadium in Troy. A thrilling 5-4 walk off victory gave the Eagles the school's first Section 2 Championship since 1974.

The Eagles next faced *Parishville-Hopkinton* in the NYS Regional Final @ St. Lawrence University Field, winning that game 13-2 to advance to the NYS Final Four for the first time in HLCS history! The Eagles headed to Binghamton for the NYS Semifinals to face Oriskany @ Mirabito Field. The Eagles magical Postseason ride ended with a tough 9-3 loss.
