VOLUNTEERING INFORMATION

The Diocese of Allentown and the State of Pennsylvania have strict requirements for parents who want to volunteer.

In order for you to volunteer, clearances must be complete and on file in the School Office and approved by the Diocese. The School sends your clearances to the Diocese for approval.

Criminal History clearance, Child Abuse clearance, DHS fingerprints and Mandatory Reporting Training are valid for 5 years. However, if you are a new volunteer your clearances cannot be older than 1 year from the day you submit it to St. Anne.

These are Diocese and State mandates, St. Anne must abide by these requirements. The approval process may take up to 4 – 6 weeks.

Summer vacation is a perfect time to complete the clearances so you are set for the school year.




