Job Summary: Orofino Junior Senior High School is seeking a dynamic and dedicated educator to serve as a Physical Education and CTE Health Occupations teacher for students in grades 7 through 12. This unique role combines middle school physical education instruction with high school career and technical education courses in health professions. The ideal candidate will foster student engagement in both physical fitness and the exploration of healthcare careers while supporting academic and personal growth in a rural school setting.

Primary Responsibilities

Physical Education (Middle School Focus):

- Teach PE classes for grades 7–8 that promote physical fitness, teamwork, and lifelong healthy habits.
- Develop and implement age-appropriate fitness and skill-based activities aligned to state standards.
- Manage equipment, ensure safety procedures, and maintain a structured and positive classroom environment.

CTE Health Occupations (High School Focus):

- Teach courses such as Fundamentals of Health Professions, Medical Terminology, and potentially Health Occupations I/II.
- Provide students with foundational knowledge of the healthcare field including anatomy, ethics, patient care, and career pathways.
- Incorporate hands-on learning, simulations, and possible field experiences to prepare students for post-secondary training and/or entry-level work.
- Collaborate with industry partners and post-secondary institutions to align curriculum with Idaho CTE Health Science standards and ensure relevance to workforce needs.

Additional Duties:

- Participate in school-wide activities, professional learning communities (PLCs), and district trainings.
- Maintain accurate records of student performance and progress.
- Communicate effectively with students, parents, and staff.
- Support student safety, wellness, and positive behavior both in and outside of the classroom.
- Assist with school improvement efforts and initiatives that promote career-readiness and physical well-being.

Qualifications

Required:

- Valid Idaho Teaching Certificate with appropriate endorsements in Physical Education and/or Health Occupations (or ability to obtain).
- Meets Idaho CTE certification requirements or willingness to pursue a Health Science endorsement through industry experience or coursework.
- Must be able to pass a criminal background check and drug screening.

Preferred:

- Experience teaching in both PE and CTE Health Sciences.
- Familiarity with rural education challenges and opportunities.
- Strong classroom management and student engagement skills.
- Ability to build relationships and inspire students of diverse backgrounds and interests.

Salary: Contingent based on education and experience.
