- ❖ Remain **above** FLDOE mandate **3% fund balance** without laying off instructional staff.
- ❖ Managing **critical facilities repairs** with limited funding.
- ❖ Ensuring Gadsden County voters understand the **significance of the half-cent sales tax** to providing quality facilities for students and staff.
