1. **Call to Order:** Pam Hilliard called the Regular Meeting to order at 6:33 p.m.
- A. Members Present:** Pam Hilliard, Lisa Hunter, Wendy Fredrickson, Daniel Moyer

- B. Adopt Agenda:** By unanimous consent, the agenda was approved.
2. **Presentation: Board Training – McKinney Vento Annual Training**
3. **Public Comments:** None
4. **Approve Consent Agenda:** By unanimous consent, the Consent Agenda was approved. Items approved: Regular Board Meeting minutes of July 14, 2025; Bills paid totaling \$402,560.56. Classified Personnel Actions included resignations from Kristina Carter, Whitney Atwood, Judy Deskins, Tyler Strunk and John Marone. Classified staff rehired for 2025-2026. Two positions for Special Ed paraprofessionals, one position for Food Service helper, and one position for bus driver are still open. The Special Education Manual (2024) was approved.
5. **Information Items:** Budget reports included: Medical Insurance Pool. Superintendent's report: **Student Achievement**—Top in the State for IRI; Student Enrollment as of 08/04/25 K-12 is anticipated at 336 with the majority of the classes at capacity. **Financial/Transparency** – The auditor will be ready to review the 2025 financial audit with the Board in September. **Facilities**—Prepping for the new year—big thanks to our summer crew. **Communications**— Back to School Information provided. Federal Programs include parent involvement review of the Title I survey/PAC as part of the title requirements. **Recruitment & Retention**—Interviews are scheduled for sped paras and food service; Update on transportation department included cross training for transportation supervisor and technician, Bus Right app, introduction to possible insurance coverage for drivers with more information to come for consideration; two administrative internships this fall; Mr. Hoffman is running for National Association of Agricultural Educators secretary position; Football Classification will fall under 1-a for the 26-27 and 27-28 school years. Chair Pam Hilliard read the thank you card from the Class of 2025 and that she had received an email from Josh Cruz regarding a wrestling program.

  - A. Approve Bus Routes:** Daniel Moyer moved to approve the 2025-2026 bus routes as established and confirmed by Troy School District Transportation Coordinator. Lisa Hunter seconded. All voted aye. Motion carried.
  - B. Approve Supplemental Contracts & Extra Duties/Activities Contracts for FY25-26:** Wendy Fredrickson moved to approve the supplemental contracts for the certificated staff and the Extra Duties/Activities for the classified staff seconded. Lisa Hunter seconded. All voted aye. Motion carried.
  - C. Approve Change of September's Regular Board Meeting:** Lisa Hunter moved to change the date of the September's regular meeting date from September 8, 2025 to September 15, 2025 at 6:30 p.m. Wendy Fredrickson seconded. All voted aye. Motion carried.
  - D. Approve Hiring Athletic Directors:** Lisa Hunter moved to approve hiring Kelly Carlstrom as .5 FTE Athletic Director and James Stoner as .5 FTE Athletic Director. Daniel Moyer seconded. All voted aye. Motion carried.
  - E. Approve Supplemental Levy Amount:** Wendy Fredrickson moved to approve running a two-year Supplemental Levy in the amount of \$995,000 each year on November 4, 2025. Daniel Moyer seconded. All voted aye. Motion carried.
  - F. Approve Supplemental Levy Resolution 08.11.25:** Lisa Hunter moved to approve the Supplemental Levy Resolution 08.11.25 for an election on November 4, 2025 in the amount of \$995,000 per year for two years for fiscal years 2026-2027 and 2027-2028. Wendy Fredrickson seconded. All voted aye. Motion carried.
  - G. Approve Mass Mailing of Levy Information:** Daniel Moyer moved to approve the mass mailing of the Supplemental Levy information pamphlet to all Troy residents. Lisa Hunter seconded. All voted aye. Motion carried.
7. **Other Business:** Supt. Klaire Vogt informed the Board that she has requested a quote to repair the outside of the bus garage on the area of brick that needs attention.
