There are many opportunities for our OJH students to participate in extra curricular activities this semester.


Odem Football has been growing and getting better each week. They are able to have both a 7th and 8th grade football team this year. Both teams have had some victories.

Odem Volleyball has started their second half of their season. They have also grown, learned, and been victorious.


OJH Cross Country has grown in numbers.
