

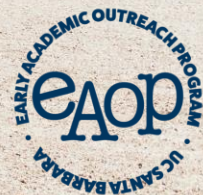

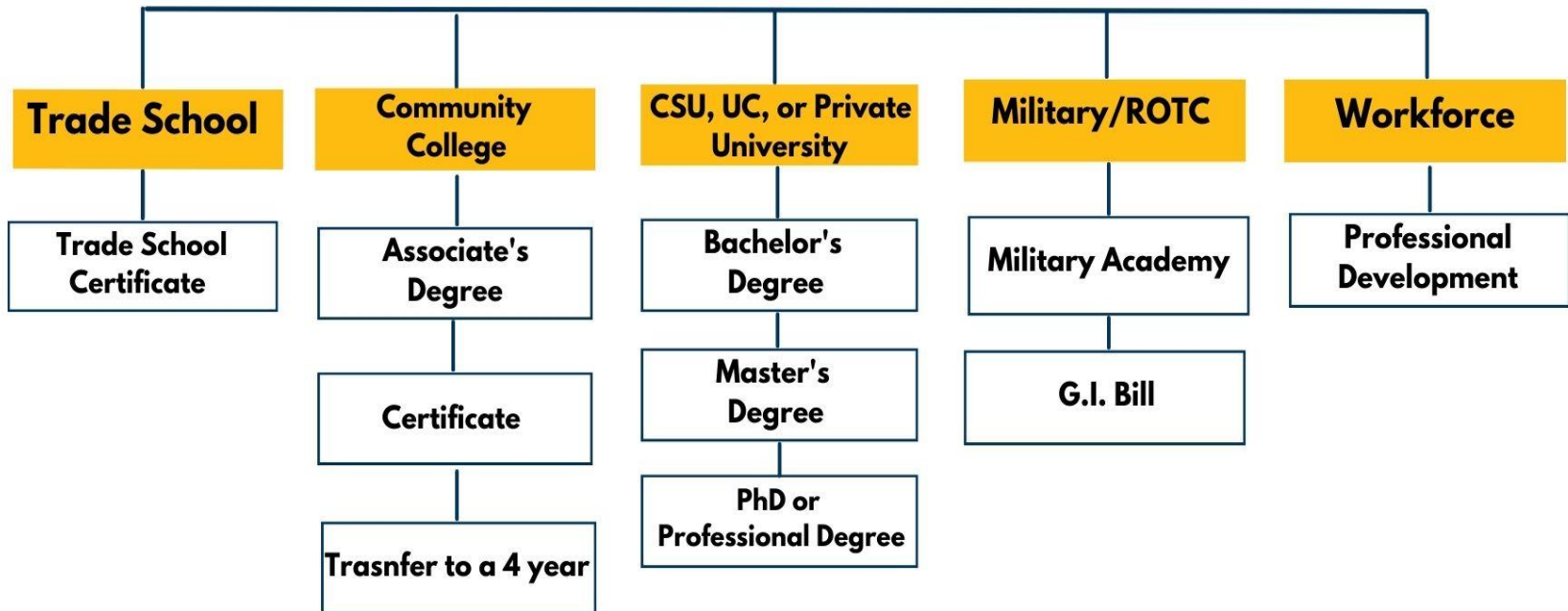

A-G requirements

- Minimum 2.5 GPA
- 2.0-2.49 May apply with Supplemental factors such as:
 - Extra Curricular Activities
 - Work experience

All classes need to be passed with a C or better

Validation for CSU & UC Admissions

Validation Rules Apply Only In:

- Mathematics
- Language Other Than English
- **CSU Only** a grade of C or better in 2nd semester of *Chemistry* validates 1st semester

Validation Means:

- A grade of C or better on a second semester course validates a D or F grade earned in first semester.
- A grade of C or better in a higher-level course will validate D/F grade in a lower-level courses.

Why Evaluate My Transcript?

Here are some reasons as how it can help:

Why Evaluate My Transcript?

- To Know what courses you can take to advance or get back on A-G track
- To be sure you are on track to graduate and/or apply to a university
- To know what schools you can apply to, based on your GPA
- Your GPA translates to MONEY. There is financial aid available attached to your GPA

GPA: Grade Point Average

Aim for those A's & B's if possible! Be strategic with the classes you are choosing and make sure you are aiming for the best grades because that makes you overall competitive!

Grade	GPA Points	Average
A	4	4.0 GPA
B	3	3.0 – 3.99 GPA
C	2	2.0 – 2.99 GPA
D	1	1.0 – 1.99 GPA
F	0	0 – .99 GPA

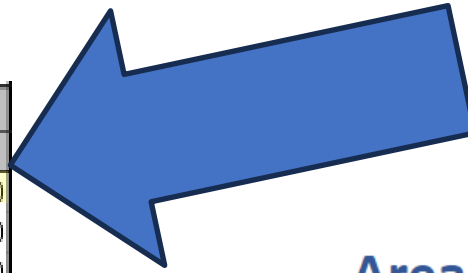



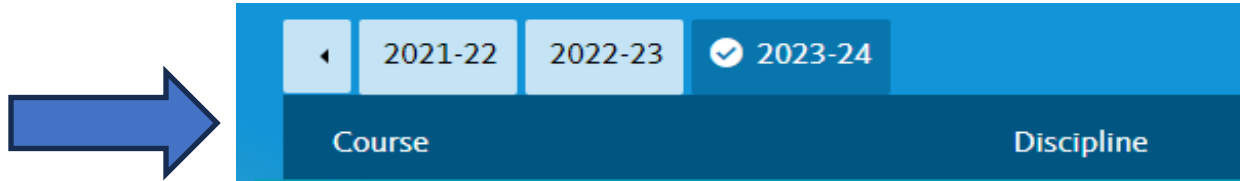
