RBHS Services include:

- Diagnostic Assessments
 Identifies, asses, provides a diagnosis, and develops recommendations for treatment or services needs.
- Therapy (Group/Individual/Family)
 Interventions which are responsive to the needs of the client for the purposes of assisting the child in solving problems related to emotional and/or behavioral issues.
- Psychosocial Rehabilitative Services (Group and Individual)
 Identifying the importance of interpersonal skills.
- Behavior Modification
 Provides a child the opportunity to alter existing behaviors to acquire new behaviors.
- Family Support
 Enables the caregiver to be a member of the treatment team and to provide and/or improve the abilities of the caregiver.
- Crisis Management
 Techniques used to help reduce the intensity of reactions to a crises and helps return student to a normal level of functioning.

*Appropriate services will be determined upon completion of the Diagnostic Assessment and the creation of the Individualize Plan of Care.

Rehabilitative Behavioral Health Services

Rehabilitative Behavioral Health Services (RBHS) is designed to serve students who have emotional and/or behavioral needs. The program is a school-centered, goal-directed, family-supportive counseling service to help stabilize or strengthen the child's placement and improve student academic and social performances. RBHS is regulated by the standards set forth through the Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS).


