Principal report (Ms. Thompson)

- Fran reports she is still doing tours and will be back in July to continue them. Tuition assistance has been rewarded and several received funds through ACE and HALO. 22 students have chosen to leave St. Joseph due to financial concerns or moved further away. They are going to public school
- Enrollment Dashboard Phil reports we budgeted at 285 students. Currently have 273 enrolled. 5 more are completing evaluations and paperwork to put us at 277.
 - Thoughts from the group:
 - Looking to connect more with St. Anthony in Wylie to attract students
 - Our base numbers look good K-3rd grade with the exception of 2nd enrollment numbers are high in the other grade levels.

Finance (Phil)

- Currently still favorable to budget due to several areas being over the amount budgeted:
 Registration, EDP, Fundraising (Auction, Hoopsgiving, PTO events: Flowers, Daddy/Daughter,
 etc.) and budgeted funds for teacher aides and security guard were able to be pushed through
 GAPS. Also, saved 25K for internet because it ended up being less than budgeted.
- We are 651k favorable to budget and 841k in rainy day fund as of the end of April.

Community Vitality (Beth)

 Beth is working on a new family welcome plan. She is currently getting new families information from Stephanie to partner new families with current families to provide support for the school year. Also, plans to give new families a call from SAC member to welcome them. In August plan is to have a popsicle party on the playground in the evening for each grade level.



Catholic Identity (Yung)

 Plans to look over current religion curriculum and talk to teachers to see how they feel it is going. Hoping to get CGS into 2nd grade, but still working on the training. Also, want to get Virtues and Saints back in Jaguar tracks.

8th **Grade Interviews (Andy)** – He is putting together a document with contact information for 8th grade parents. He will get that send out to volunteers along with questionnaire to SAC members to contact next week. Daniel suggested sending a text first asking if they will participate and to schedule a time to call and chat.
