Policy & Expectations



- **Dual Enrollment students are enrolled in two schools at the same time following TWO academic calendars.**
- It is the student's responsibility to keep up with school events and activities. (ordering of Cap and Gown, pictures, registration, club meetings, voting for senior awards, etc.) Students should regularly check the **Grade-Level Google Classroom**, school social media sites, and the VHS website (Senior Calendar of Events) to stay informed.

Grades



- **Weighting Policy:** 5 points will be added to the final grade for degree-level academic CORE courses if credit is earned (English, Math, Science, Social Studies & Modern Language).
 - Any elective course (including academic electives like PSYC 1101) will **not** receive any extra points.
 - Some colleges provide letter grades instead of numerical grades. In those circumstances, we use the conversion chart below for determining grades.
 - If a college sends the numerical grade, we will honor the grade sent and add the additional 5 points for the appropriate classes.

Grades



Dual Enrollment	Grade Conversion Chart for Letter Grades:
Grade at College	Grade at High School
A	95
B	85
C	75
D	65
F	60

Students must earn a grade of 70 or higher in a course to earn the rigor points.
70 (credit earned) + 5 = 75 on Transcript 65 (credit NOT earned) = 65 on Transcript

Students MUST notify Mrs. Coleman prior to changing or withdrawing from any Dual Enrollment class. DE students are allowed 2 withdrawals without penalty.

If you receive a grade in a DE class, the grade will be on your transcript.

Campus Parking



All Students- on side of school

Before school you may enter through the **BACK** entrance.

After 7:30 all should enter the building through the **FRONT OFFICE** entrance.

Do not use the doors behind the gym or in guidance;
you will lose your parking privileges.

Parking Permit- Mrs. Thompson will be issuing these. DE students must return the signed Dual Enrollment Contract to her along with their signed Parking Permit Form to get a parking permit. More info to come...

Arriving & Departing Campus



Notes for absences may be turned in to the Front Office or the Guidance Office.

Signing In: Front Office ONLY

Signing Out: Front Office ONLY

Entrance after 7:30 am Front Office ONLY

Students may not linger in the building.

When leaving the Vidalia High School campus to attend a dual enrollment course, students must be off campus before the bell to start the next block. If you have any questions or concerns please see Mr. Strobridge, Coach Freenor, or Coach James.

When returning to Vidalia High School to attend a class, students must arrive **prior** to the start of class and must enter through the front office.

1) Complete Orientation Part A

New Students must complete DUAL ENROLLMENT Orientation Part A. Visit the [STC Homepage](#) and follow these steps: [Admissions](#) → [New Student Orientation](#) → [Dual Enrollment Orientation Part A](#).

2) Bring Student ID

Students without a college student ID will have one created — required for books and proctored exams. Parking decals will be issued to students taking classes on the STC Campus.

3) Print Semester Schedule

Print class schedule, including semester start and end dates, by going to [MySTC](#). Students will be prompted to [enter a username](#), which is a student ID number (9100xxxxx). Click [My STC Experience](#) → [Registration Tools](#) → [Print my Schedule](#) → [Select Current Term](#) → [Print](#). If you have never logged in or do not know your password, click [Help](#).

4) Need Help?

Students are encouraged to bring their school-issued Chromebook or personal laptop to check on any login issues with MySTC or Blackboard. Check for Understanding



1. **Purpose** of the Dual Enrollment Contract - clarify student responsibilities while enrolled in two schools
2. **Who** do you return signed contract to if you are **NOT** purchasing a parking pass
3. **Who** do you return signed contract to if you **ARE** purchasing a parking pass
4. How many rigor points are added to eligible **core** dual enrollment course grades?
5. What is the **minimum grade** required in a core academic course to receive rigor points?

True / False

If a student fails or withdraws from a DE course, it might affect graduation or athletic eligibility.

Students must follow the VHS dress code only when they are on the VHS campus.

All Grades received in a DE class appear on the student's transcript.

DE/WBL Students are allowed to hang out on campus between classes.

DE/WBL Students will park in the student parking lot on the side of the building.

Reminders



Eligibility- MUST be enrolled in 3 classes all semester to be eligible. Cannot drop 2 classes in same semester.

Graduation- MUST complete all graduation requirements

GPA- All courses taken through DE count in your GPA

HOPE only pays for a DE class once. If you have to retake it you will have to self pay.

To **DROP** a class you must get permission from Mrs. Coleman AND complete the DROP form on MySTC.

Grade- No one can see your grade but you and your professor. DO NOT wait until you are too far in a hole to get help if you need it.
