The group was provided guiding questions by the Polk County Local Education Agency Individual school information regarding how parents are informed about:

Florida Standards and Next Generation Sunshine State Standards for Science are the curriculum for our K-5 students.

Students in K-5 will be given Progress Monitoring Assessments three times a year in reading, writing, math, and science. Students will also be given various assessments as directed by the administration to track individual student achievement and assist teachers in delivering data driven lessons and making instructional adjustments.

The proficiency levels for progress monitoring in reading, math, and science are set at 70% while the writing proficiency is based on the state assessment for grades

4-5 and varies in grades K-3. Teachers collaborate to decide the proficiency rate for their grade level.

Achievement standards are set at 70% for Progress Monitoring in reading, math, and science. In grades 3-5, it is based on the state assessment for reading, math, and writing and science is based on a 3 or higher on the FCAT. Students in grades 3-5 will take the state assessment. 5th grade students will also take the FCAT 2.0 Science test.

Monitoring student progress —parents may contact teachers at anytime.
