NOTE: Fan Ejections Policy - Below are spectator sanctions concerning ejections / unsportsmanlike behavior while attending an AISA athletic contest.

- A \$300 fine and a 2 (two) game suspension for football
- A \$300 fine and a 4 (four) game suspension for other sports
- If less than the above minimum games remain, the fine will be \$500 in addition to the remaining games
- 2nd ejection: spectator is suspended until he/she meets with the Athletic Committee during the next scheduled meeting

Any person guilty of unsportsmanlike involvement with the players, coaches, officials, and/or other fans before, during, or after any AISA interscholastic event may be fined \$500.00 and the school(s) represented by the involved may be placed on a minimum of one (1) year probation. All fines are due to the AISA office within thirty (30) days.
