Still waiting for the AC part! Please continue to pray for a resolution to this problem.

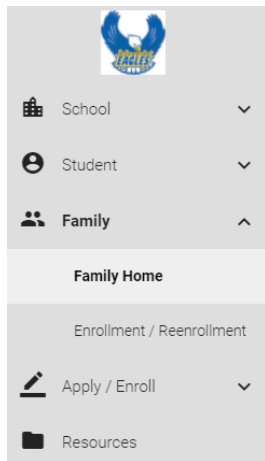
Oct. 26, 6:15 pm Parent Meeting Grades 6-8

- ✓ Select “Family Home” from the drop down menu;
- ✓ On the “Family Home” page, locate “Family Billing”; click on “Details”.

We depend on parent’s regular monthly payments to help us cover our costs. Timely payment of these bills is an important parent responsibility.

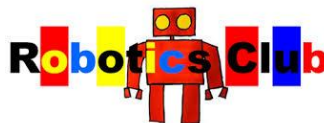
Guardian Catholic COVID-19 Report Line 904-705-3827
