Overview of SIC Meeting on Thursday, November 3, 2022

The meeting began at 6:00 pm, and handouts were presented to SIC members consisting of the principal's PowerPoint, the meeting agenda, and a copy of the school report card for 2022. After going through JMS state scores from spring of 2022 and the school report card results, the principal shared school incentives that JMS has created to encourage students to make academic gains. Reading Plus, i-Ready, and Dream Box Math information and incentives were discussed with parents as well. (See Power Point attached)

Principal shared that the JMS Facebook site had 880 followers and how the website is parent and student friendly. Information about what could be found on the website page was also shared.
