PARENT INFORMATION REMINDER

As we get ready to start the new school year there are a few reminders. We ask you kindly to read the **Parent Communication Packet** that is usually sent home by Option C every Thursday. Important information and events that you need to know are always included.

ALL absences MUST be reported by 8:45 a.m. For your convenience, the telephone messaging service **answers 24-7.** You may call anytime to report your absence. If the absence is not reported by that time, it is marked as "Negligence of Parent" on Option C.

If you have **any changes** to dismissal, such as car rider, bus rider, walker, Extended Care, from what your child was told in the morning, please call the Main Office by 2:25 p.m. Once dismissal begins, the telephone will not be answered until dismissal is over. It is best to call the Main Office instead of contacting the teacher by email. Teachers, at times, do not have the luxury of checking their messages because of teaching.

If your son or daughter needs to leave early for an appointment or any other reason, please notify the teacher or Main Office at the **BEGINNING** of the day. It is not fair to keep interrupting the education environment for these dismissals. We understand that emergencies arise, but please follow the policy that is requested.

If your child is experiencing symptoms of illness, please **do not** send them to school. It saves you, the parent/guardian the hassle of having to come pick them up and it also keeps the other students and teachers safe and healthy. Your child could be sent home if they arrive ill. If your child misses 3 or more consecutive days they will need a doctor's note upon returning.

These above items are meant for the health and safety of your child and others. We want to maintain a sound academic environment as well. Thank You for your attention regarding these matters. We look forward to the upcoming school year!

INSTRUMENTAL MUSIC FAQS FOR PARENTS



Does my child need to know how to play an instrument to join?

No. We teach your child everything he/she needs to know to play their musical instrument.

When do lessons begin for students?

First lesson dates vary by school. Dates are listed on the enrollment page when you register your child for lessons. Once registered, you can expect an email from your child's teacher within a week of the first lesson.

When do lessons occur?

Your child will receive one (1) 30-minute small group lesson each week. All lessons are scheduled during the school day. Lessons are scheduled on a rotating basis so students don't miss the same class each week.

What grades are eligible to participate?

In most schools, students can sign up for a string instrument as early as 3^{rd} grade, and band instruments starting in 4^{th} grade. Some schools have different requirements. Contact your school or music teacher to confirm specific offerings.

How much does participation cost?

There are two components to participation in the program: tuition and a **quality** musical instrument. Refer to the attached flyers for tuition and rental instrument pricing.

If my child doesn't sign up now, will he/she be able to later?

Although we do not recommend delaying enrollment in the program, we do welcome registrations throughout the year. Students that join the program mid-year will have to work diligently to catch up to their peers. Our teachers will do their best to get your child caught up.

Will participation affect my child's grades in other subjects?

It will almost surely help them. Research has shown that band has a positive influence on other studies. Music students consistently average higher grades than non-music students.

Can you be in the band/orchestra and be involved in other school activities like sports, cheerleading, dance, step, chorus, or art?

Absolutely! Most of our music students are involved in other electives and activities.

My child is involved in so many activities. Won't those activities affect his/her performance in band/orchestra and vice versa?

Music students often have many varied interests that make them among the busiest students in the school. The experience that they gain in balancing these interests and activities often proves to be one of life's most valuable lessons.

What should I do if my child is struggling?

Practice is a key component for improvement; students must practice in order to improve. If your child is practicing and still struggling with their instrument, contact your child's music teacher for suggestions. Above all else, remain positive and encouraging as your child learns this new skill.

Will my child have an opportunity to perform?

Yes! For beginning students, your child will have at least 1 performance this year. For advanced students, there will be a minimum of 2 performance per year. In addition to school concerts, there are other opportunities to perform in our annual Northeastern Honor Band festival, Archdiocese festivals, and other performances arranged by your child's teacher.
