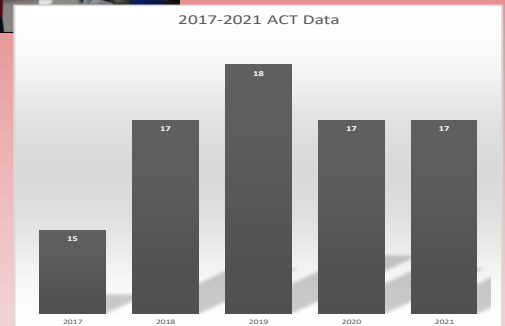
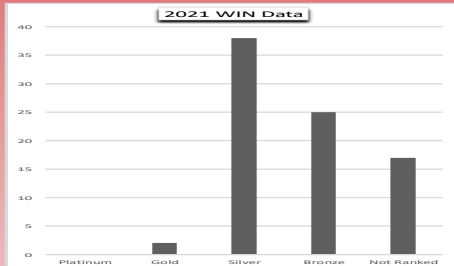

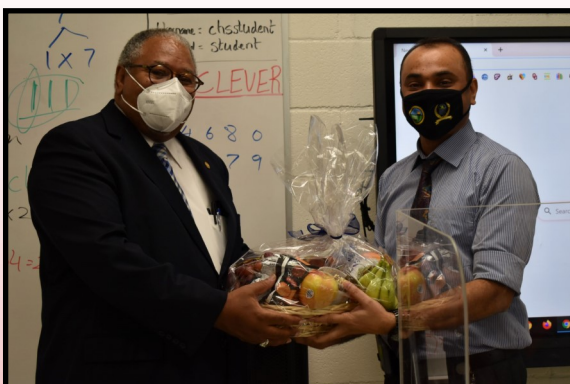
## Academic Accomplishments
