

- Encourage reporting




Education

- Define bullying as an unwanted, repeated, intentional, aggressive behavior that involves a real or perceived power imbalance
- Discuss Upstander Power-peers can stop bullying. Encourage your child to: not join in or laugh, comfort the student being bullied, or tell a trusted adult.






