

Required Documents for Medicaid Enrollment Interview

What you need to bring to your Medicaid Enrollment interview:

Reminder, client MUST have an email address to create a Your Texas Benefits account to apply for benefits.

<u>Social Security Card or Documentation</u>: Is required for all Medicaid services except Medicaid for Pregnant Women or CHIP Perinatal

Identification: Driver's License, State ID, School Enrollment Records, or Passports.

Proof of Income:

- Check Stubs
- Award Letters (benefits verification letters) for Social Security
- Tax Return (Form 1040, Amount on Line 9)
- Assistance Letter (Form H1134) for clients who state they have no income but are receiving assistance from someone or live with someone else
- Clients being paid in cash from employer; can have written letter from employer or have employer complete Form H1080
- Self-employed clients who don't file Taxes can complete Form H1049

<u>Proof of Address</u>: These documents typically include your full name and residential address. Acceptable forms of proof of address include:

- Utility bills
- Bank statements
- Rental agreements

Additional Requirements:

Newborns: Verification of Birth Facts (hospital provides this certificate when child is discharged)

Medicaid for Pregnant Women and CHIP Perinatal: Documented proof of pregnancy

Children's Medicaid: Birth certificate for children born outside of Texas

Medicaid for Foster Youth: Legal documentation of foster care

Medicaid for Disability:

- Supplemental Security Income Documents
- Home and Community-based Services Documents
- Proof of disability such as a physician's medical diagnosis and/ or other medical records
