Communities In Schools

Sandi Norman, Director of Communities in Schools of Randolph County, reviewed information of two site coordinators positions to be funded by CISRC through True North Funding. Ms. Norman explained the funding would pay for 2 site coordinators, with one being at Randleman High and the other at Randleman Middle. The funding will pay 100% of the positions for the first year. CISRC/ RCS will need to provide 30% of the funding for years 2 and 3. Ms. Norman reviewed grant requirements, salary, selection process of the two positions, and the needs for the site coordinators at the individual school site. T. McDonald made a motion seconded by E. Coltrane to approve site coordinators positions as presented. Motion carried: 6-0.

Activity Bus Plan Update

Marty Trotter, Assistant Superintendent of Operations, presented an Activity Bus Plan Update. He stated the purpose of the activity bus plan committee is to review billing, replacement schedule, cost of a new bus, cost per mile and current fleet. North Carolina's school bus replacement schedule sets the standard at 20 years old or 200,000 miles. Average age of RCS activity buses is 19 years, with 23 buses being older than 20 years. An additional 18 buses fall between 10 – 19 years. The cost of an Activity Bus ranges from \$75,500 - \$88,000 along with some additional costs. Mr. Trotter also reviewed facts in the day to day operations of our current fleet of activity buses.
