COVID-19 REPORT August 17, 2021

To keep our families and community informed, Mobile County Public Schools is posting this dashboard showing the number of new positive COVID-19 cases reported each day, by school. The figures reported here show the number of employees and students combined who notified us that they had tested positive for COVID-19. The data is reported by our schools at the end of each school day and is posted the following business day. It is important to note that numbers represented in our dashboard indicate data as reported to us by parents, students, and personnel.

If you or your child was in direct contact (which, per current CDC guidance is within 3 feet for 15 minutes for children in school settings; or within 6 feet for 15 minutes for adults or for a child and an adult) with an individual who tested positive for COVID-19, you will be notified and receive recommendations on what to do.

With every positive case, Mobile County Public Schools will enact our COVID-19 safety procedures, which include asking the individual who tested positive to self-isolate, thoroughly disinfecting all areas of the school or facility where this person has been, and working along with health officials on any further steps that must be taken. We follow the most current recommendations of the Centers for Disease Control, the Alabama Department of Public Health, the Mobile County Health Department, and the Alabama Department of Education.

Due to federal privacy laws under the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA) and the Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act (HIPAA), Mobile County Public Schools will not identify the names of individuals who have tested positive and will not share information that may allow others to be able to identify them.

We appreciate your help in keeping our students and employees safe by notifying us immediately if you or your child tests positive for COVID-19.
