Steps to Complete for School Bus Training

- 1) A potential driver must identify a sponsoring school.
- Potential drivers will need a CDL permit in hand before training begins. - Register for FMCSA https://clearinghouse.fmcsa.dot.gov/
 Look for the Red Stop sign in the middle of the page and click on <u>READ MORE</u> link and follow instructions. To expedite please register to receive notifications electronically.
- A Physical or DOT is required to drive a school bus in Alabama. The physical form (see the link) can be completed by your family physician and or most Immediate Health Care Facilities. - 5) Set up driver's AIM account at <u>https://aim.alsde.edu/</u> Once your user name and password have been created please complete the following steps. Select Transportation tile, New Application tab and complete the demographics and the questionnaire. *If there are questions from AIM concerning background review please contact (334) 693-4557*
- 6) After AIM account is created, log in to AIM and select the 'Fieldprint Background Check' tile as shown below
- 7) Driver will be Drug Tested and will be directed by the Transportation Dept to an outside agency.
- Students must complete ELDT Theory training. Enrollment will be directed to Kecia Forehand at Wallace Community College. Copy of Permit with email address and phone number. Should be sent to <u>KForehand@wallace.edu</u> Trainces will receive registration instructions via email from ACCS
