Fellowship and Enrichment Tutoring Program

The Hopkinsville Christian County YMCA Tutoring Program provides free tutoring services to vulnerable youth ages 12 to 18. As part of the YMCA's youth initiative, the program seeks to remove financial barriers to private tutoring, helping students succeed academically and pass their required courses. Students are selected for the program based on financial need, academic challenges, and their commitment to attending weekly sessions.

Tutors and volunteer tutors act as learning guides, assisting students with difficult concepts and boosting their confidence in problem-solving. Volunteers also serve as positive role models and mentors, often sharing career advice and personal experiences. All volunteers receive ongoing training in YMCA Mission and Values to ensure they positively influence the youth they work with.

Each session provides students with homework support, a meal, and a safe, encouraging environment to build confidence and develop their skills. Tutors assist in all academic subjects, and support is available four days a week. Students also receive a teen membership to the YMCA, granting access to the Teen Center, gymnasium, and fitness equipment.

The Tutoring program is open to 25 students. All participants must complete the Open Doors Scholarship form, program registration form, and membership application packet.

Tutoring sessions will be held Monday through Thursday with Fridays reserved for students to enjoy access to the teen center, gymnasium, and workout facility supporting their development in sprit, mind and body.

Enrollment includes attendance for tutoring four days a week, following the school calendar, through May 2025.

Who can apply?

All middle and high school students age 12 and 18 who are enrolled in school in Christian County, KY during the 2024-2025 school year are eligible to apply.
