UNIFORM POLICY

GRADE REQUIREMENTS

Reading, Language Arts, and Math will have 3 Major Tests, 3 Minor Quizzes, and 2 additional quizzes per quarter. Major 60%, Minor 30%, and Additional 10%

Science and Social Studies will have 3 Major Tests and 3 Minor Quizzes per quarter.

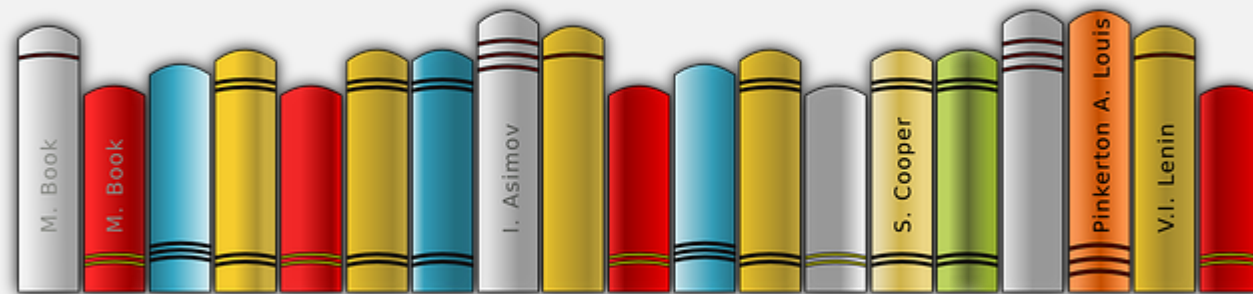
RETESTS: Students are allowed one retest on one major test per subject per quarter. This is for the first test in which the student made a 59 or below. Writing is not retested.

CARP

Third graders will check out two library books a week.

The books need to be read in class and at home. Picture books need to be read more than once. Students should take tests on both of their library books by the day they go to library.

Students must maintain above an 85% and make their personal goal to have their names called at the honor roll assembly and attend CARP celebrations.





PROMOTION AND RETENTION

- Students must achieve a minimum yearly average of 70% in each subject.
- If a student has a yearly average of 60-69%, students will need to attend their attendance zone school.
- The student who receives a yearly average of 59% or below in any subject will be required to return to the attendance zone school for another year of 3rd grade.

HONOR ROLL

- A HONOR ROLL
 - 90-100% in each subject area including conduct and work study
- A/B HONOR ROLL
 - 80-100% in each subject area including conduct and work study
