Re-Opening Plan for the 2023-2024 School Year

The Fannin County School System (FCSS) offered face-to-face instruction for all students during the entire 2020-2021 school year with a virtual option for students and parents who preferred a virtual environment.

FCSS followed all Department of Public Health (DPH) COVID-19 contact tracing and quarantining protocols during the 2020-2021 school year.

All FCSS facilities were provided with a fogging and disinfecting system. These systems were utilized to disinfect certain classrooms and areas of the facilities after a known positive COVID-19 case.

The FCSS custodial staff and maintenance team followed all normal cleaning and disinfecting procedures during the 2020-2021 school year.

Following these protocols and procedures helped to mitigate the spread of COVID-19 within our schools and keep the number of positive COVID-19 cases low amongst our students and employees even in the height of the COVID-19 pandemic.
