40	Unit 1: Rules and School Essential Question: How can I learn safely and responsibly? Focus: Rules at school Concepts: learning and following the rules at school, different roles and responsibilities of family and school personnel, resolving conflicts independently, peacefully and safety.
40	Unit 2: Our Country Essential Question: How do we celebrate our country? Concepts: Veterans Day, our nation's flag, holidays may be celebrated differently in different families.
40	Unit 3: Historical People and Needs and Wants Essential Question: Who are Martin Luther King Jr, George Washington, and Abraham Lincoln? What is the difference between a need and a want? Concepts: Martin Luther King Jr, Presidents Day, George Washington, Abraham Lincoln. Needs and wants
40	Unit 4: Maps Essential Question: What is a map? How do I read a map? Concepts: Exploring a map, using positional words.
