Grades

- *Major assignments account for 65% of your grade. These include tests, projects, essays, etc.
- *Minor assignments account for 35% of your grade. These include in-class assignments, bell work, discussions, quizzes, participation, etc.
- *If an assignment is not completed during the allotted time in class, it will need to be completed as homework.
- *Anytime you do not submit an assignment (whether due to an absence or any other reason) *OR* do not submit with your name on it, a grade of zero will appear in PowerSchools. This is not permanent and will change *IF/ONCE* the assignment is submitted.
- *Make-up work is *YOUR* responsibility and must be completed within 2 weeks of your return.

Classroom Expectations/Consequences:

Arrive to class on time, prepared, and ready to work. Refer to the below Discipline Plan for full list of rules and consequences.

- 1. Show respect and be kind to others. It costs \$0 to be kind and respectful.
- 2. Keep yourself to yourself. Stay out of everybody's business and keep your hands to yourself.
- *3. Follow all classroom routines and procedures.* We want this class to operate like a well-oiled machine. We have routines and procedures that will make this happen. We will practice them over and over until we're all on the same page. Trust me, it will make our days *so* much better.
