



Application Procedures and Guidelines

1. The award must be applied to tuition, room and board, and books.
2. Deadline Date: **Sat, April 22, 2023** (late or incomplete applications will not be accepted)
3. Two (2) scholarships will be awarded in the amount of \$1,000.00 for graduating high school seniors with a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0.
4. Recipient of award will be publicly recognized
5. Scholarship check will be made out to the student's school.

Scholarship winners will be notified of their selection no later than:

Friday, May 5th, 2023 for presentation on 9 MAY 2023
