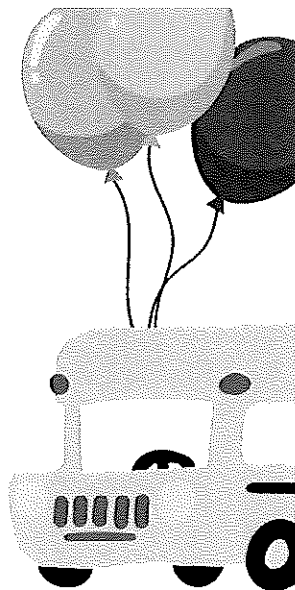
Non-Discrimination Statement

Permission slips will go home the week of May 4, 2026!



