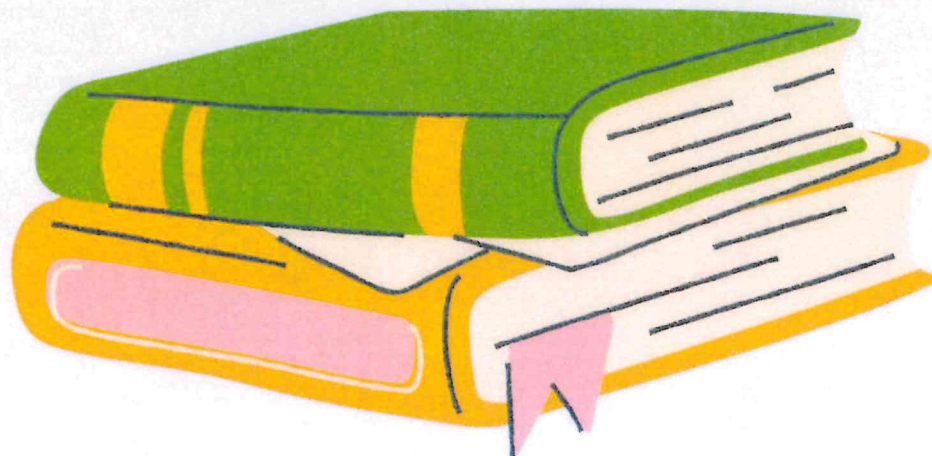

- **Create new eWallet to apply the balance.**
- Visit <https://bookfairs.scholastic.com/bf/stanneschool4>.
- Follow the eWallet setup steps.
- Once a new eWallet is created, choose how to fund the eWallet.
- To apply balance, select first option, "Fund with an eGift Card Balance" and check box displaying available balance.
- Click the Fund button, and a confirmation will display with the option to Manage My Funds.
- Here, add funds and invite family and friends to contribute.

Your student can ask the cashier to round up their purchase to raise more funds for St. Anne.
