Vocabulary Words-harvest, larva, lays, leap, pale, pests, pupa, someday

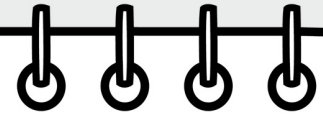
Writing-Opinion

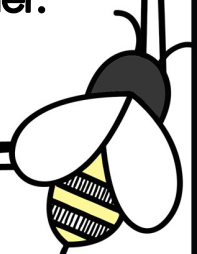
