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Tattnall County High School Dual Enrollment Guidelines

Tattnall County High School offers an opportunity for students to obtain college course credit through the Dual Enrollment program. Juniors and Seniors are the suggested demographic of students to take advantage of the Dual Enrollment program; however, Sophomores may participate if readiness is proven by meeting the criteria.

Junior & Senior year

A student can participate in the dual enrollment program their Junior or Senior year with the qualifications below:

- A student must be in good standing academically and on track to graduate.
- A student must have good attendance.
- A student must understand that disciplinary issues can impact enrollment in dual enrollment.
- A Students must meet the admissions requirement of the college.

*Sophomore year

10th grade students may ONLY participate in the dual enrollment program and receive high school course credit, if each of the following criterion is met.

- A student must meet the state required SAT 1200 or ACT 26.
- A student must be in good standing academically and on track to graduate.
- A student must have good attendance.
- A student must understand that disciplinary issues can impact enrollment in dual enrollment.
- A student must meet the admissions requirement of the college.
