



Recycling Reminder!



Junior High Student Council would like to remind families to talk with your kids about what can and cannot go into the school recycling bins. We can only recycle paper, clean cardboard, plastic bottles, and aluminum cans. Please make sure your child knows that no food or liquids should be placed in the bins. When food or drinks are tossed in, our student council members get covered in sticky messes while emptying them. Also, the trash cannot go through the recycling machines. Thank you for helping us keep recycling clean and safe!



Recycling Rules Made Simple!

Goes in the bin:

Paper & cardboard (like cereal boxes)
Plastic bottles & jugs (water bottles & milk jugs)
Metal cans (soup & soda cans)
Glass bottles & jars (juice bottles & jelly jars)

<u>Does NOT go in the bin:</u>

Plastic bags (take them to the store instead)
Food or messy pizza boxes
Styrofoam (squeaky cups & trays)
Batteries & electronics
Clothes & shoes
Easy tip:

If it's squishy, soggy, or stinky it's NOT for the recycling bin!
