With the new school year starting we are eager to share updates to our admission requirements, upcoming events, and important information with you!

UWG is Test-Optional for Select Students

We are excited to announce that we are waiving our SAT and ACT test requirements for first-year applicants through 2023-2024 academic year with a 3.2 GPA or higher! This group of students is no longer required to submit test scores with their application for admission. As a reminder, this GPA is calculated by our Admissions team based on only required high school courses. Students who fall below this GPA may still apply with SAT or ACT scores under our standard admissions requirements.



ACT On-Campus Offered at UWG

For Freshman and Dual Enrollment applicants who need to submit test scores, it's never been easier to test to go West. UWG is offering the ACT On-Campus, a special ACT test opportunity available only to UWG applicants. For a limited time, we are providing the ACT On-Campus at both our Carrollton and Newnan locations for free. Tests are available on multiple dates to fit busy student schedules. Students can register to test at Carrollton here or at UWG Newnan here. Note: Scores from the UWG ACT On-Campus are only applicable for admission at UWG and may not be submitted to any other institution.



Go Apply! Go West!

Our application for Fall 2023 is open now! UWG's Early Action deadline is October 15.

Students who apply by this deadline will get first-choice access to the housing application, giving them their first pick of building and room assignments. Early Action applicants will also receive priority recognition for scholarships. Students who are ready to Go West can apply here!

Afford West

The University of West Georgia is committed to providing a financially accessible education for our students. As part of this commitment, we have redesigned our scholarship model, creating pathways to award based on both academic achievement and financial need.

Campus Visit and Events


