- Working as a team/an individual to complete assignments

Students who are comfortable in front of a camera. These students will read the morning announcements and introduce other segments of the show. This position requires students who have good oral reading skills and are confident speaking in public.

Students who understand graphic design or are willing to learn the proper techniques for graphic design.
