As you are aware, 2025 has delivered lots of inclement weather. I'm sure you know that we have reached our built-in snow day limit. Tennessee Code Annotated 49-6-3004 states that school systems may utilize 2 virtual learning days during inclement weather. These days do not have to be made up. Cumberland County Schools has chosen to use these days.

How this will work for families:

- 1. Schools will be notified when there is a chance of inclement weather;
- 2. Teachers will send home some additional work;
- 3. IF there is no school and it is announced an inclement weather virtual day, during the day teachers will notify you and your child to answer/address any questions;

Should we exhaust these 2 days and miss more, please be on the lookout for a survey to provide your input on how to make up additional missed days. Thank you for your patience and understanding.
