SHAWL MINISTRY: Prayer shawl ministry has changed meeting times. We will meet the third Monday of every month. For more information contact Mary Evans.

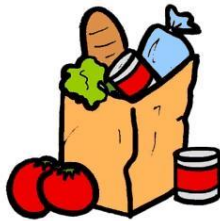
SVDP MEETING: Our next meeting will be Sunday, September 19th after Mass.


