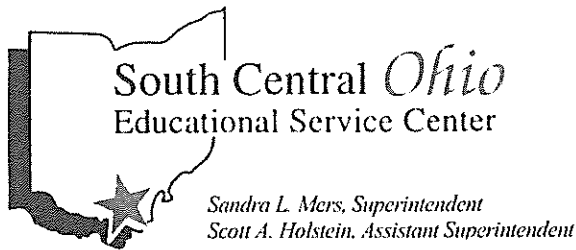

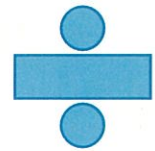

Brian first came to us 11 years ago as our Elementary Assistant Principal. After 1 year we moved him to Principal of that building where he performed strongly in that role. 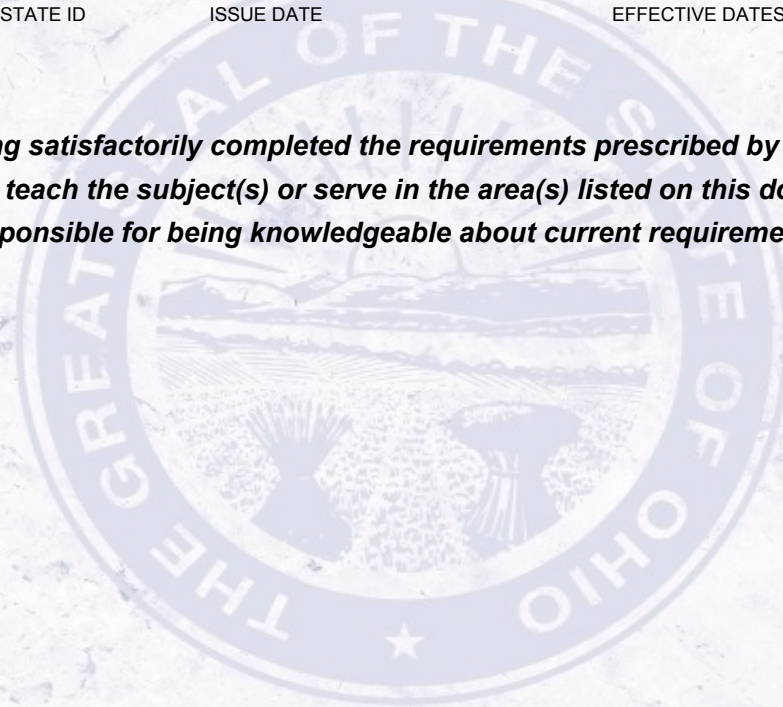

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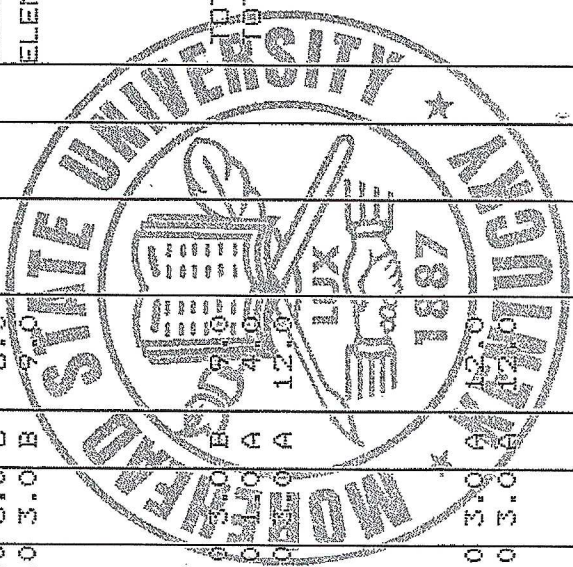
