Keep in contact with your scholar's teacher by phone or email to check on his/her academic and behavioral progress.
- 6. Make time for reading at home. Encourage your son/daughter to read his/her Accelerated Reader book(s) for 30-60 minutes daily using the computer or cellular phone.
- 7. Provide computer with internet access at home. You and your scholar may practice skills taught in the classroom by visiting educational websites such as <u>www.khanacademy.org</u>.
