



DUAL ENROLLMENT ELIGIBILITY

Bevill State Community College 2022-23

DUAL CREDIT:

- Students must be in the 10th, 11th, or 12th grade for Dual Enrollment credit.
- Students must take state-approved college placement tests for college level English, Speech, and Math (ACCUPLACER).
- Academic students must have a minimum cumulative (unweighted) grade point average of 2.5 on a 4.0 scale for Dual Enrollment Credit.
- Career technical education students must have a minimum cumulative (unweighted) grade point average of 2.0 on a 4.0 scale for Dual Enrollment Credit for Welding and Pipefitting; however, they must have a minimum cumulative (unweighted) GPA of 2.5 on a 4.0 scale for Dual Enrollment Credit for Computer Science and Electrical Systems Technology. (These are the CTE Dual Enrollment classes taught at P4C.)

TO MAINTAIN CONTINUOUS ELIGIBILITY, A STUDENT MUST EARN A "C" OR BETTER IN ALL ATTEMPTED COLLEGE COURSES.

STUDENTS WHO FAIL TO MEET THIS MINIMUM GPA OR WITHDRAW FROM A COURSE WILL BE SUSPENDED FROM THE PROGRAM FOR A MINIMUM OF ONE TERM. THE ONE-TERM SUSPENSION MAY NOT BE SERVED DURING THE SUMMER TERM.
